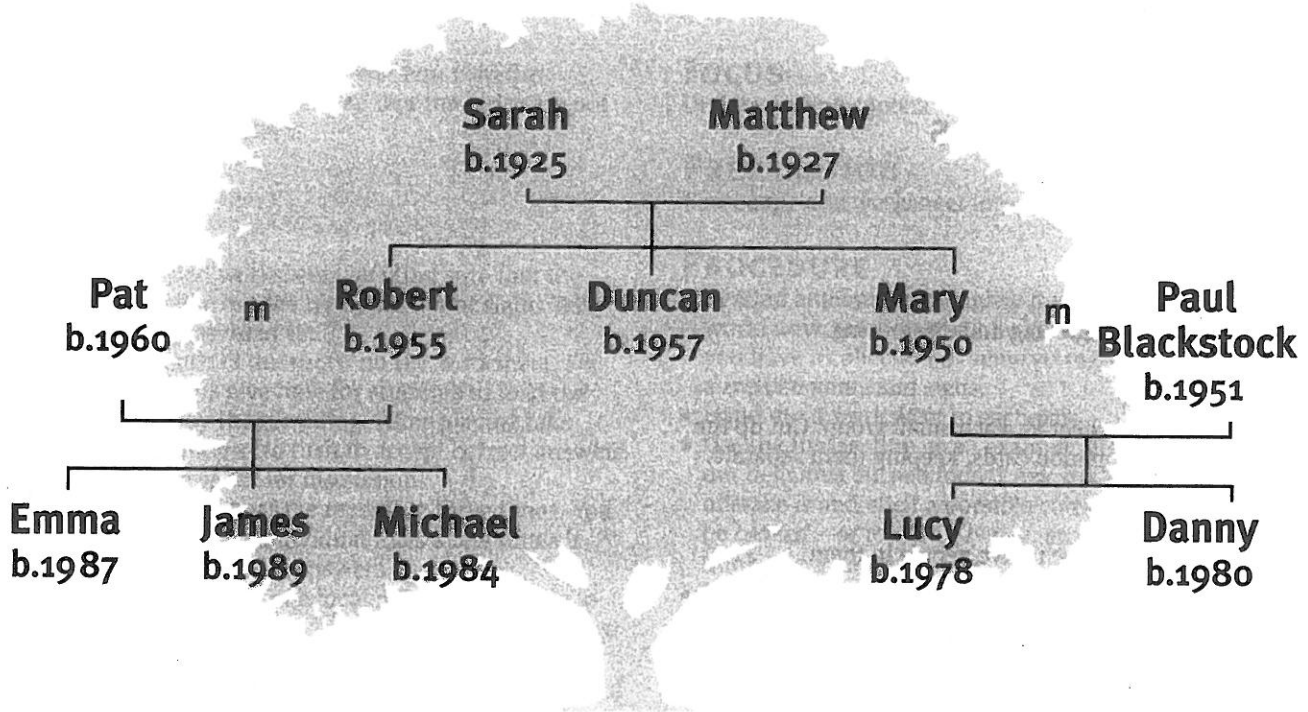


1A | The Johnson family tree

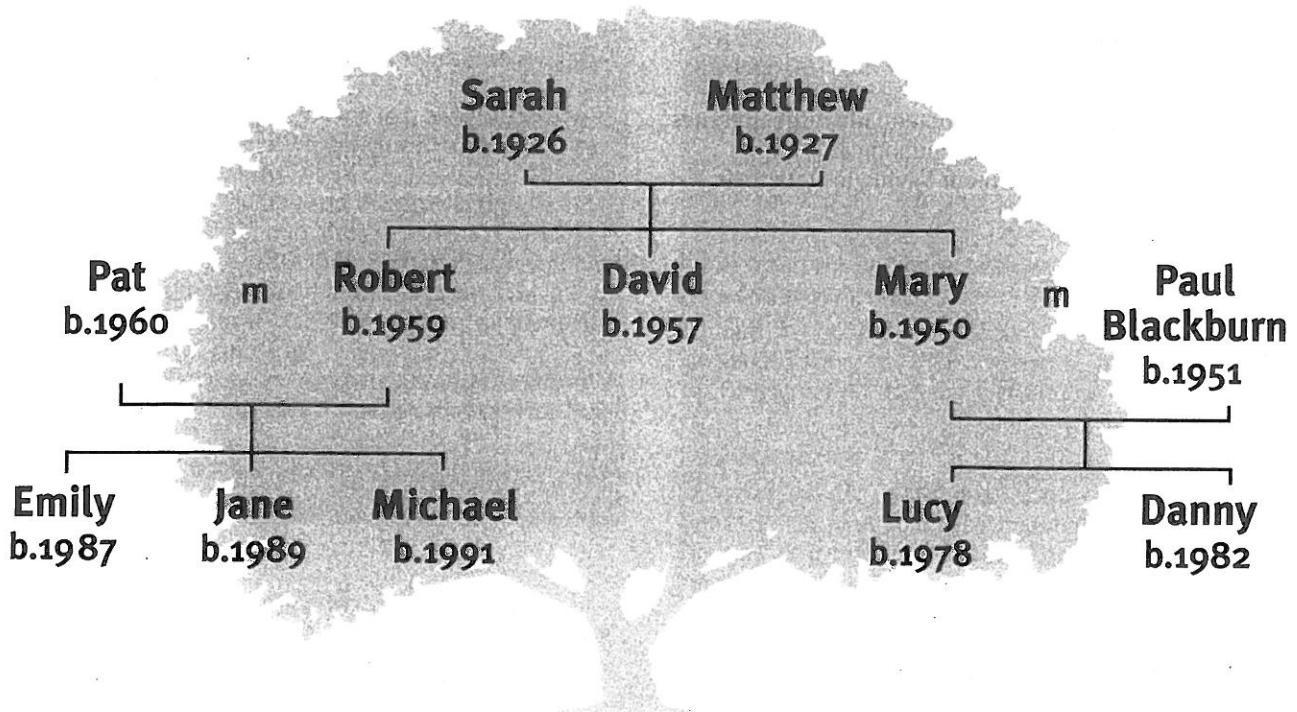
A Look at the family tree of the Johnson family. Then ask and answer questions with your partner to see how many differences you can find.

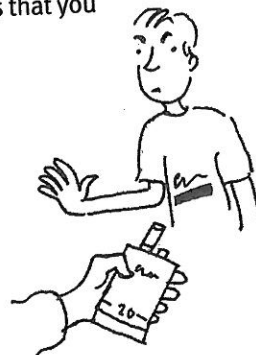

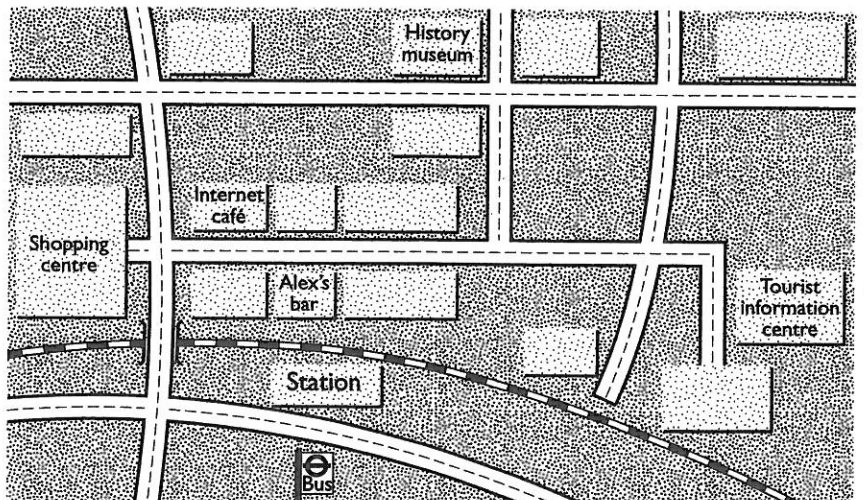

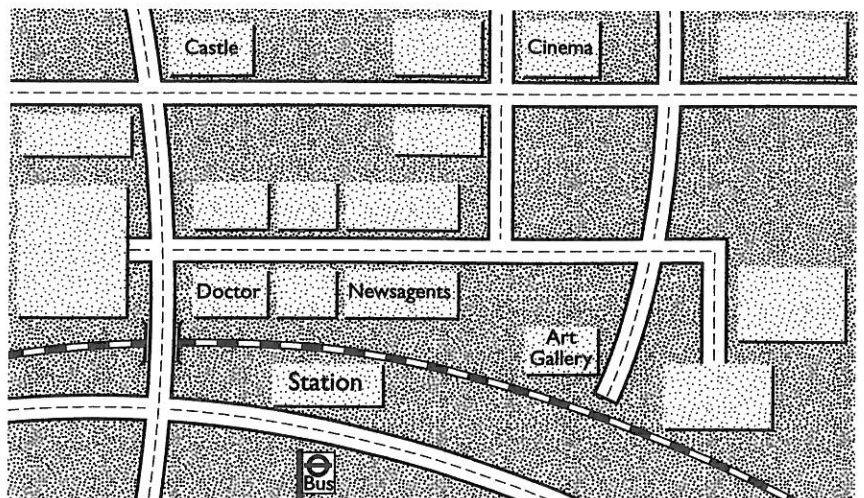

... had to borrow money to do something special

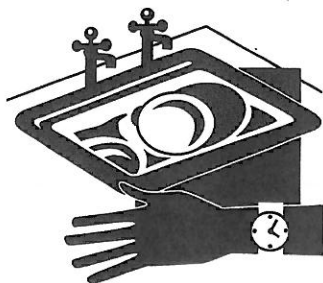
... could stay up late

Friend

You're in a fashionable clothes shop with a friend. Your friend is trying on a pair of jeans but he or she looks terrible in them! You need to persuade him or her not to buy the jeans but your friend and the shop assistant both think they look good. Use these ideas:

- they're expensive
- it's not a designer label
- they're a bit too expensive
- they don't suit your friend at all – the colour is terrible
- nobody needs more than one pair of jeans
- there are other shops that sell nicer clothes
